### COMMON HOLIDAY CONTAMINANTS

Continue battling recycling contamination with us during the holiday season! Keep these common contaminants out of your recycle bin.



#### **NO Plastic Bags, Film**

Take plastic bags back to your local grocer to keep bags clean and dry, and prevent them from shutting down recycling facilities. Visit [plasticfilmrecycling.org](http://plasticfilmrecycling.org) to find a drop off location near you.



#### **NO Electronics & Small Appliances**

Donate these items if they are in good condition. Check [earth911.com](http://earth911.com) for a local recycling site.



#### **NO Recyclables in Plastic Bags**

Empty loose recyclables in bin but leave the plastic bag out.



#### **NO Holiday Lights**

Donate these items if they are in good condition. Visit [earth911.com](http://earth911.com) to find recycling options.



#### **NO Ribbons, Bows, Foil & Glitter Wrapping Paper**

Plain, paper based wrapping paper can be recycled.



#### **NO Trees, Tinsel, & Ornaments**

Donate these items if they are in good condition. Otherwise, they belong in the trash.



#### **NO Clothing**

Donate these items if they are in good condition. Otherwise, they belong in the trash.

Hello Williamson County! Just as we were in spring, we are keeping busy here at the landfill. We completed our cell project in mid-June. We anticipate this cell will last another twelve months, and with that, we hope to start our next construction project in late spring or early summer. This past spring and summer were a great success with two different HHW events being held, one in Cedar Park and one in Leander. Your continuous efforts to dispose of household hazardous wastes safely and correctly are a testament to the residents of this great county and show how much you all care about doing your part. As these events are so successful, we will hold another two, possibly three next year. We chose Cedar Park as the location of our spring event, taking place on April 27th, 2019. Remember this is a FREE event, so don't miss out on your opportunity to kickstart spring cleaning.

As we did last year, Williamson County Landfill will accept Christmas trees for free composting. From Dec 26 to Jan 11 any Williamson County resident can drop their tree to be composted providing it is free of lights, tinsel, and ornaments. Free recycling applies to real trees only. Please dispose of fake trees with landfill trash.

Last but not least, we'd like your help in ensuring all employees arrive home safely to their families every evening. Given the yearly time-change, residential employees may be servicing your community during twilight and evening hours. Please encourage members of your community to pay close attention to our employees while they are working on public roadways.
