Before the end of the year, the landfill will begin expanding its gas system by adding six new vertical wells and eight new horizontal wells. These wells are an important components of a landfill, helping reduce any potential odors to ensure we remain a great neighbor. The project should wrap up in early 2025.

Aside from working to ensure everything runs smoothly at the landfill during this busy time of year, we've also been spending time in the community sharing information about recycling, the landfill, and our biannual HHW events. We provided free disposal vouchers to the Keep Hutto Beautiful for the Great Hutto Cleanup in October, worked with local law enforcement to help a resident in need of disposal services in November, and hosted a booth at multiple events

throughout Williamson County. Looking ahead to next year, I am a pleased to announce in April we will sponsor the Hutto Chamber of Commerce monthly luncheon and host our first HHW event of the year at the Williamson County Expo Center. More information about those two events will be shared in the first part of 2025.
